

## Access to The Geneva Academy Campus for Persons with Disabilities

### → The Villa Moynier (120 B rue de Lausanne)

---

The ground floor of the Villa Moynier is accessible for persons with disabilities through the rear entrance of the villa. (See map below)



Parking for disabled persons is available at Villa Barton, upon request of a parking ticket at the reception of the Villa Barton (rue de Lausanne 132) or La Perle du Lac (rue de Lausanne 128).

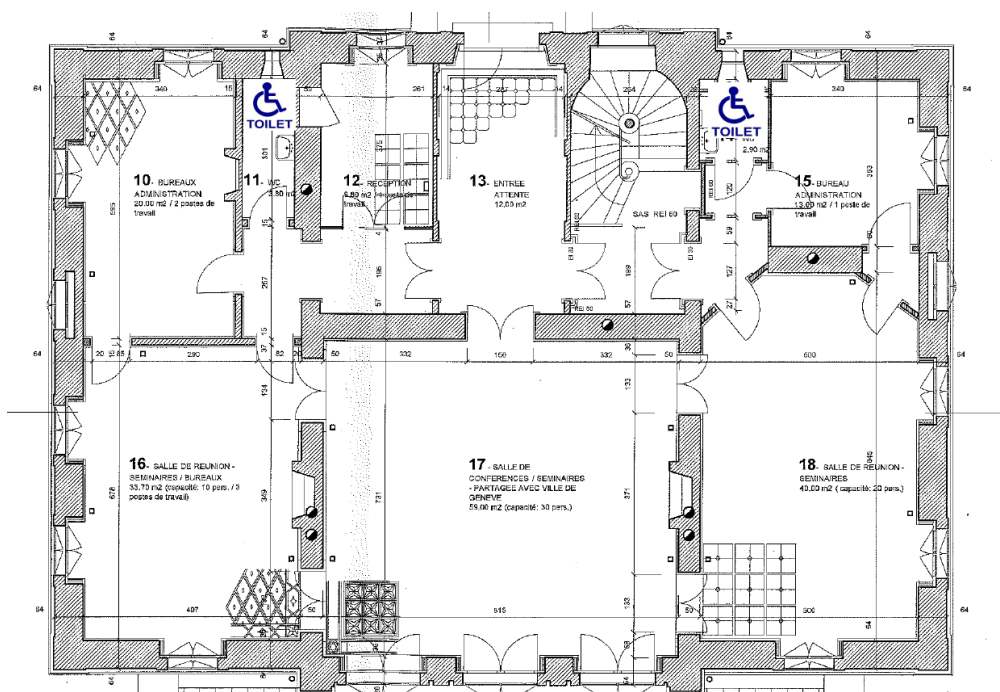
Once you are in front of the rear entrance, please ring the interphone to call the reception and request assistance. One of our staff members will then assist you in handling the platform to help you into the building.



Please note that only the ground floor is accessible to persons with disabilities.

Since it is a historical villa, no lifts were authorized on the inner wooden staircase. Should you have an appointment on the first floor, our staff will book a room downstairs and hold the meeting there.

Two fully equipped lavatories accessible for disabled persons are available on the ground floor (see map below).





## → The Auditorium Jacques Freymond (AJF) – 132 rue de Lausanne

---

Should you have a course, lecture or training at the AJF, kindly inform the Geneva Academy staff (reception, coordinator or teaching assistant) prior to your arrival. The entrance to the AJF for persons with disabilities is situated on the ground floor (cafeteria area) where a lift is available to access the first floor (see picture below).

A fully equipped lavatory accessible for disabled persons is available on the ground floor of the building.



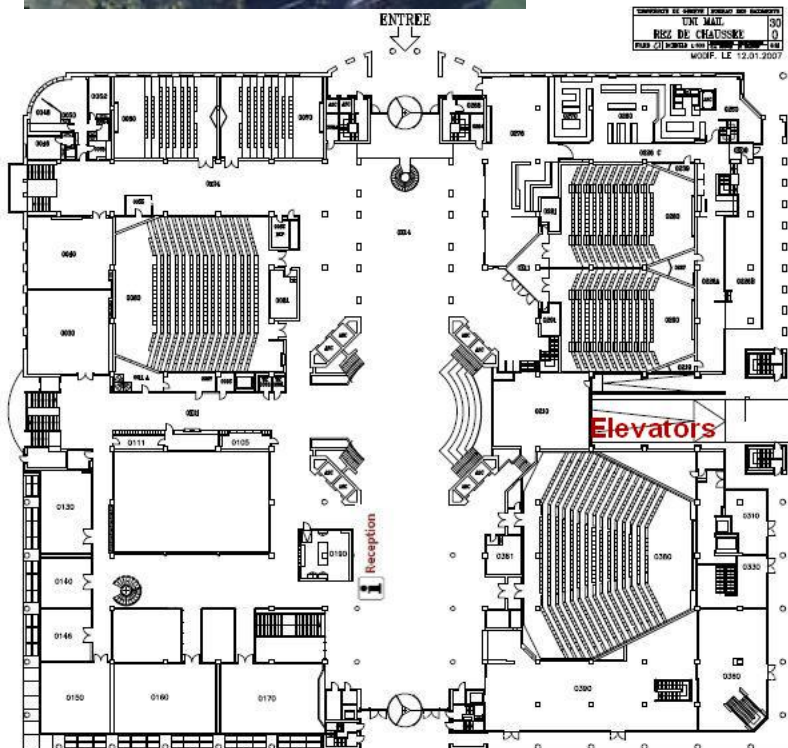
Parking for disabled persons is available at Villa Barton, upon request of a parking ticket at the reception of the Villa Barton.

## → Villa Barton - 132 rue de Lausanne



Villa Barton is fully equipped for persons with disabilities. A ramp is available to enter the Villa.. Students and/or participants can access all rooms with the elevator. Fully equipped lavatories are available on every floor.

## Uni-Mail (UNIGE)

Uni-Mail classrooms and libraries are accessible through the elevators situated in the right-side center of the building (see map). Fully equipped lavatories accessible for disabled persons are available on every floor.

Should you need any assistance or need to access the rooms on level -1, please require assistance at the reception on the ground floor.

A public (paying) parking is available under the building and is accessible through Boulevard Carl Vogt.





## → Maison de la Paix (The Graduate Institute) – Chemin Eugène-Rigot 2

---



Maison de la Paix is accessible through the elevators situated on the side of each petal (building). Lavatories accessible for disabled persons are available on every floor next to the elevator area.

Should you need any assistance, please contact the reception on the ground floor of pétale1 (or by phone 022 908 57 00).

To access the conference rooms (Auditorium Pictet, A2 and inter-pétales rooms) or the library, kindly use elevators from pétale 1.
